Passed

A – Support Repeal of Ratification Deadline for ERA

We think we are already doing the 3 Bullet Points in the final “Be It Further Resolved”. Perhaps the ERA Committee could look at this for suggestions.

B – Immigration Rights Campaign

We think this could be referred to Immigration Committee for implementation.

D – Aid to Puerto Rico

We think the Combatting Racism Task Force should ask for research on the current status from staff members to be followed up by an article on the web page.

E – Police Accountability

We need more information from the Combatting Racism Task Force before we can make a recommendation.

G – Removal of Confederate Flags and Monuments

Same as previous

H – Expose Crisis Pregnancy Centers

We recommend creating a tool kit for activists to be disseminated on the web site “What NOW”

I – Trans Inclusivity

We think the 1st “Be it Further Resolved” has a budget implication and needs to be discussed by the Board. The “Be It Finally Resolved” needs to be reviewed by the By-Laws Committee.

K – Abortion, Birth Control and Contraception

We believe the Action Center is doing this work already.

L – Pre K through 12 Sexual Violence

We are confused and think this should be referred to whatever committee is working on violence against women for suggestions.

Referred to the Board

We believe NOW has already taken this position and we don't recommend passage.

Equal Pay Bills in 50 States

We would like to ask Jacqueline Kozen (Hearing Co-Chair) or whoever she recommends for more insight
