 - ▶ Coordinated with SC Consultants and NAC Staff regarding programming for each event
 - ▶ Lead outreach initiatives to recruit panelists, guest speakers, and moderators
- Pathable Contract
 - ▶ Total: \$10,980
 - Duration of Contract: 1 year
- Features: product support, experienced consultation, group trainings, on-demand tutorials, rapid-response support ticketing system, dedicated "day of" support for additional costs
