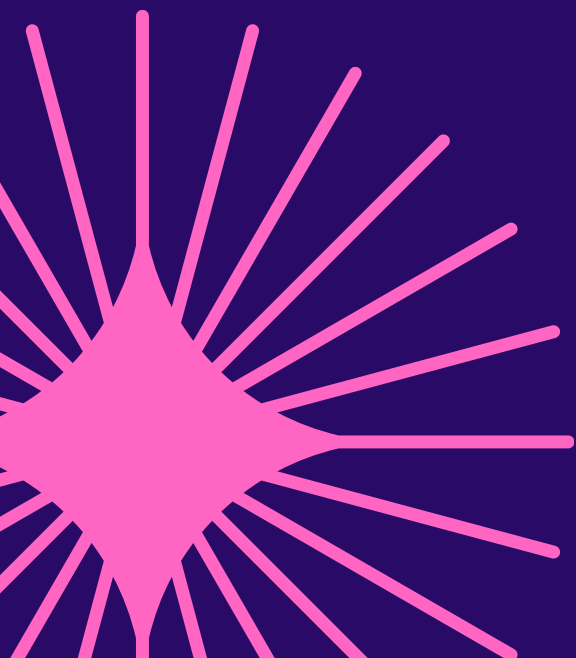

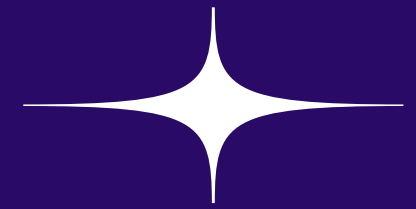

Mia Dent

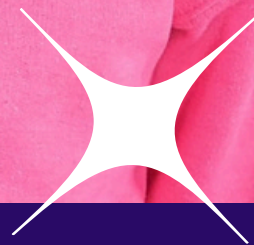
Co-Chair

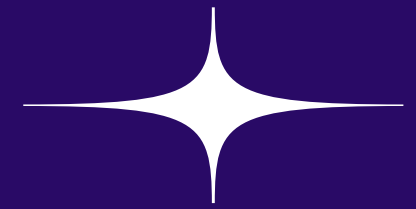
Mia's primary areas of advocacy include environmental justice/climate change, and mobilization of GenZ to use their voices in political and social justice spaces.





Laura Libby

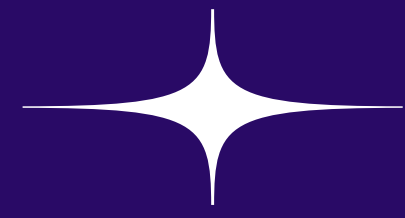
Co-Chair

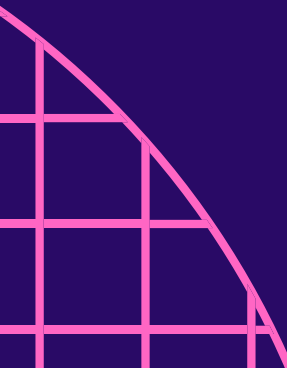


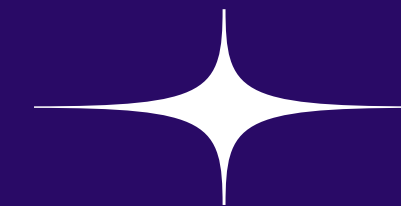
Bailey Toler

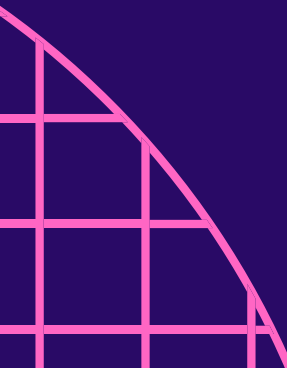
Nani Hilden

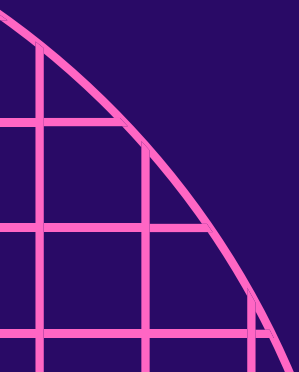
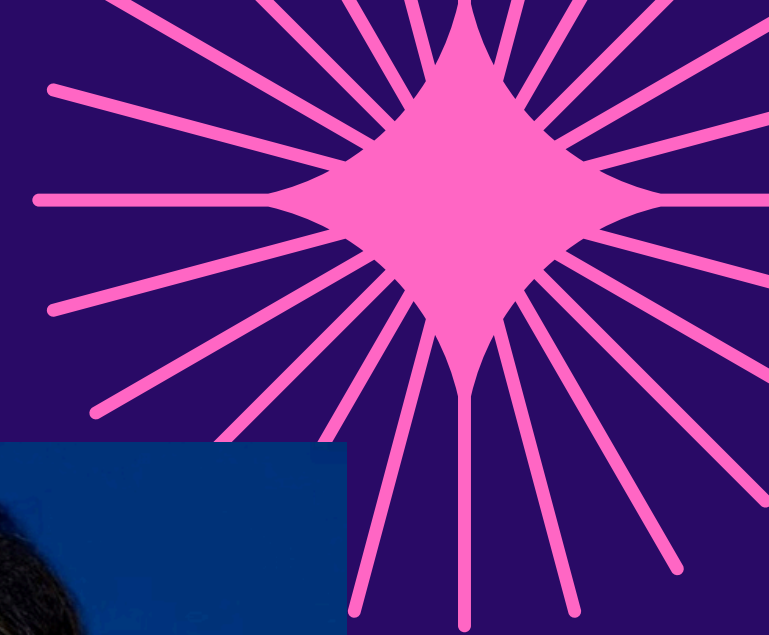
Nani is ultimately committed to advocating for equity and justice for all women and is very excited to begin with NOW.

At-Large (Young Professionals)

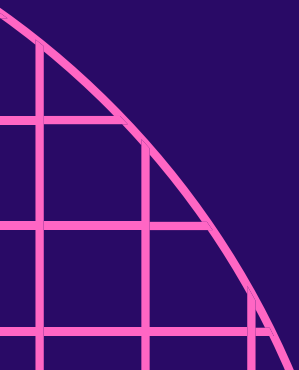
